

Reflections on Creation: Nebulae and Galaxies by James Moore-Smith

We are about to sing about the fantastic power of God the creator and all the works his hand has made. Evidence of the immensity and breath-taking might of our creator are apparent in the following images and I would like to share with you some of the facts and figures of his creation because we are apt to forget just how mighty God is!

The Hubble telescope website (hubblesite.org) allows us to see far away worlds in space that allow us to get up close and personal to some of the never before seen products of The Creator's work. Let me show you!

The [Butterfly Nebula](#)

What resemble dainty butterfly wings are actually roiling cauldrons of gas heated to more than 36,000 degrees Fahrenheit or 20,000 degrees Centigrade. (When you consider boiling water is only 100 degrees Centigrade, you get some idea as to how hot this gas is). The gas is tearing across space at more than 600,000 miles an hour—fast enough to travel from Earth to the Moon in 24 minutes. A dying star is at the center of this fury. It has ejected its envelope of gases and is now unleashing a stream of ultraviolet radiation that is making the cast-off material glow.

The [Orion Nebula](#)

This dramatic image offers a peek inside a cavern of roiling dust and gas where thousands of stars are forming. More than 3,000 stars of various sizes appear in this image of the Orion Nebula. Some of them have never been seen, before the Hubble telescope found them.

[Whirlpool Spiral Galaxy](#)

The graceful, winding arms of the majestic Whirlpool spiral galaxy appear like a grand spiral staircase sweeping through space. They are actually long lanes of stars and gas laced with dust.

This final image is of the so called [Eagle Nebula](#):

Appearing like a winged fairy-tale creature poised on a pedestal, this object is actually a billowing tower of cold gas and dust rising from a stellar nursery. The soaring tower is 9.5 light-years or about 57 trillion miles high, about twice the distance from our Sun to the next nearest star.

[Butterfly Nebula](#) again

The even more miraculous fact is that he, The Creator, created you and me from gas and dust similar to that speeding through space at 600,000 miles per hour. Even more miraculous is that Jesus (indeed The Creator's Son) was also fashioned from this dust and he died for you and me.

It has been said that we have somehow lost a sense of the magnitude of God in our modern times, that we reduce God to a convenient part of our lives and we reduce Him to a fraction of His fantastic power.
